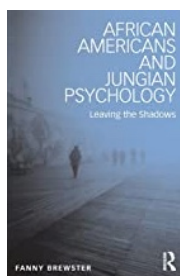

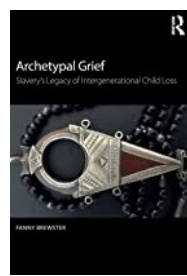

Please use the chat area to write questions and comments. Due to large attendance, attendees will be muted until the discussion portion of the evening.

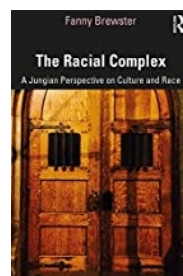

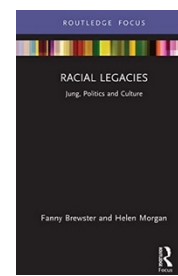
